The Leadership Team met on June 14, 2018. The Team discussed plans for summer worship. The first Sunday with one 10:00 AM Sunday service will be June 24. A midweek meal and worship experience will begin at 6:00 PM on July 11. Five youth and three adults leave for the National Youth Gathering in Houston on June 26. Faith Formation for the summer will include a series of films at 11:15 AM on Sunday mornings which address the theology of the civil rights movement and the challenge that theology presents to people who are fairly comfortable. These films will help provide energy for the studies/projects planned for the fall regarding environmental awareness and caring for immigrants. The Team also discussed other studies and plans, including a study of the role of women in the church and women as Lutheran clergy, and a plan for assessing the needs of our neighbors at BU, Brookdale, Vestal Hills Elementary School, and others in the area.
